Beautifully set within a 1,500 acre estate that spans both banks of the River Boyne, Slane Castle is an iconic 18th-century architectural gem that has been home to the Conyngham family for more than 300 years.

Visually breath-taking, this landscape of rolling hills and sloping lawns includes a natural amphitheatre in front of the castle which has hosted the legendary Slane Concerts for over four decades that have featured some of the world's leading artists including The Rolling Stones, David Bowie, Queen, Bruce Springsteen, Metallica, U2 and most recently Harry Styles.

Take your place within the fascinating history of Slane Castle through a guided tour of the Castle and a stroll in the grounds where you are surrounded by the birds, wildlife and woodlands of this magnificent estate. Alternatively, create your own narrative through exclusive hire of the castle complete with seven beautifully decorated Castle rooms. You will also have access to the Castle's state rooms, including the magnificent neo-gothic King George IV Ballroom that has been used by Royalty and rockstars and which houses a imposing portrait of the King who was a guest of honour in 1821 when he stayed to visit his mistress, the first Marchioness Conyngham. **Highlights include:**

<p>Rock Farm Slane</p>	<p>Rock Farm Slane is a 90-acre award-winning organic farm, designed with permaculture principles, on the historic Slane Castle Estate. Led by the pioneering, aristocratic farmer Carina Conyngham (Countess of Mount Charles) and her family, a tour of the farm offers insights into daily life for the self-sufficient and hard-working Conynghams. <p>Boyne Valley Drive</p>	<p>Follow in the footsteps of Irelands ancient High Kings and wander through 9,000 years of rich Irish history on the 190km or 120mile Boyne Valley Scenic Drive, County Meath. The epicentre of Irelands Ancient East, county Meath is still known as the Royal County as High Kings have sat here since the second century AD. <p>Brú na Boinne</p>	<p>Just 9 kilometres from Slane Castle lies the World Heritage Site of Brú na Boinne. The archaeological landscape is dominated by the three well-known large passage tombs, Knowth, Newgrange and Dowth, built some 5,000 years ago in the Neolithic or Late Stone Age. The Brú na Bóinne tombs, in particular Knowth, contain the largest assemblage of megalithic art in Western Europe. The new state of the art, immersive visitor experience focuses on the monuments of the World Heritage Site during the Neolithic period. The exhibits explore the seasonal nature of Stone Age society, the significance of the solar cycle, ceremonies and the monument building process.</p> <p>www.discoverboynevalley.ie</p>
<p>Slane Food Circle Artisan Food Tours</p>	<p>The Slane Food Circle offers the opportunity to meet like-minded artisan producers on their farms and in their workplaces to understand what living on and from the land means to them and their families.
